Dr. An-Pang, Kao has been the president of Kainan University since 2007. He was born in 1953 in Taipei, Taiwan.

He received his bachelor degree in economics from National Chengchi University, Taiwan. Afterwards, he served with the Marines as a lieutenant for 2 years. Then he went to study in the U.S. He received his masters in East Asian Studies from National Chengchi University and in Agricultural and Applied Economics from University of Wisconsin-Madison, and received his PhD in Resource Economics from University of Massachusetts.

He specializes in political economy, applied microeconomics and environmental economics. He is also a specialist in the Chinese Economy.

Afterwards, he returned to Taiwan to teach at Chengchi University. He became a full professor in 1993, Chairman of the Economics Department in 1998, and Dean of College of Social Sciences in 2001 before becoming president of Kainan in 2007. He was president of Asian Consumer and Family Economics Association (ACFEA) from 2003-2005. He has been a consultant to the Taipei City government since 1998.
